Happy New Year...

Let's make 2025 the year that every single person on the planet starts seriously considering their environmental footprint and the impact it has on, well, basically everyone

According to current statistics, the world generates over 2 billion tons of municipal solid waste annually, with projections showing this number could increase by 70% to reach 3.4 billion tons by 2050; the United States produces the most waste per capital, with the average American generating around 4.5 pounds of trash daily; only about 13% of global waste is currently recycled, and a significant portion of waste is mismanaged, particularly in low-income countries; plastic waste is a major concern, with millions of seabirds and marine mammals dying from plastic debris each vear.

Key points about environmental waste statistics:

Global waste generation: Over 2 billion tons of municipal solid waste is generated globally every year.

Projected increase: By 2050, global waste generation is expected to reach 3.4 billion tons.

US waste generation: The United States is the top waste producer per capital, with an average of 4.5 pounds of trash generated per person daily.

Recycling rate: Only around 13% of global waste is currently recycled. Stop throwing it away.

Mismanaged waste: A large portion of waste, especially in low-income countries, is mismanaged, leading to environmental pollution.

Plastic pollution: Plastic waste poses a significant threat to marine life, with millions of seabirds and marine mammals dying from plastic ingestion. Microplastics from clothing!

Start to improve your environmental footprint this New Year, focus on practices like reducing energy usage, consuming less, recycling more effectively, composting food waste, using reusable bags, conserving water, opting for sustainable transportation, and minimizing plastic use by buying products with less packaging. Key areas to focus on

Reduce waste: Recycle properly

Compost food scraps. Use reusable bags and containers. Buy products with minimal packaging. Buy local and buy LESS.

Conserve energy: Turn off lights when not in use. Unplug electronics when not in use. Consider energy-efficient appliances.

Water conservation: Fix leaky faucets. Take shorter showers. Use water-efficient appliances. Install a water cistern or rain collector. Refuse to buy water in plastic water bottles.

Diet changes: Eat raw and fresh real food. Choose locally grown produce or grow your own. Reduce food waste

Transportation choices: Walk, bike, or use public transportation more often. Carpool when possible. Consider an most cost effective vehicle.

Sustainable shopping: Buy second-hand clothing. Look for eco-friendly labels on products. Avoid fast fashion. Don't throw away usable fabrics or clothing. Buy organic material

Besides cosmetic products like shampoo, toothpaste and scrubs, it is now clear that clothing is a source of microplastics; acrylic, nylon and polyester are especially major culprits. With acrylic, more than 3,000 fibers per gram can be released in one wash. And one fleece jacket of 680 grams loses almost a million fibers at a time.

Mile Markers – What's the Deal?

MILE US 1 is used to travel the islands of the Florida Keys. Location: along the hightway are expressed by Mile Marker numbers. The ZERO Mile Marker is found in Key West, Mile Marker numbers 2 continue to increase until the pass through the Monroe County line at Mile Marker 112, north of Key Largo. Look for small green signs with white numbers posted at each mile along US 1 (these used to be the original mile posts installed along the old railroad bed).

Special note: Mile marker references are commonly used in localaddresses. When there is a B or O this denotes either Bayside (north-Gulf of Mexico side) or Oceanside (south-Atlantic Ocean side) location.





MONROE COUNTY MAKES DECISION ON RATE OF GROWTH ORDINANCE (ROGO) REQUEST TO THE STATE

FLORIDA KEYS, FL – The Monroe County Board of County Commissioners adopted a resolution at a special meeting on Thursday to request that the state legislature adopt amendments to increase the hurricane evacuation clearance time for permanent residents for the Florida Keys Area of Critical State Concern from 24 to up to 26 hours to allow a maximum of 3,550 new residential permit allocations countywide.

Of the additional new residential permit allocations within the unincorporated Monroe County, 1,350 would be reserved for issuance of only one allocation per vacant buildable parcel, regardless of maximum development potential. In addition, 70 percent of those 1,350 allocations will be designated as 99-year deed-restricted workforce market-rate housing where at least 70 percent of the occupant's income is derived from employment within the Florida Keys. Any allocations above the 1,350 that may be approved by the State (up to 26 hours) for unincorporated Monroe County could be used for affordable, workforce, or market-rate housing. The Monroe County allocations would be distributed evenly over a 40-year period, excluding workforce market rate and affordable housing allocations, which may be borrowed forward.

Monroe County's legislative delegation, which includes State Rep. Jim Mooney and Senator Ana Maria Rodriguez, will utilize this input to form a bill they would be willing to support to be approved by the legislature for this to go into effect.

The legislative session starts on March 4, 2025.
